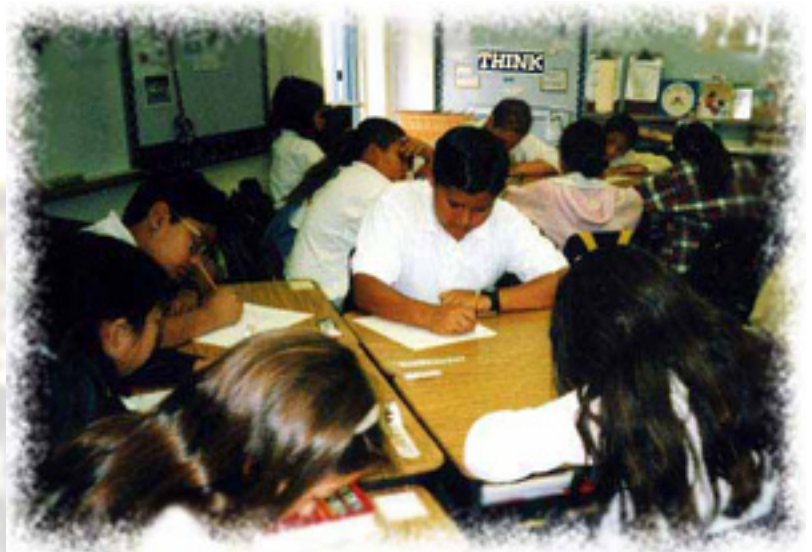


Learning to Write Writing to Learn
